Cultivation of Azolla for profitable Livestock and Poultry farming

Rationale

Profitable livestock farming depends largely depends on increasing production without escalation in feeding cost In recent days,. Azolla can be used as an ideal source of feed for cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, rabbits and fish as an alternate source to a concentrate / feed / fodder to improve the production status of the animals. Azolla contains 25-35% protein on dry weight basis and rich in essential amino acids, minerals, vitamins and carotenoids. The shortage of fodder is, therefore, being compensated with commercial feed, resulting in increased cost of production of meat and milk.

KVK Intervention

- KVK imparted capacity building programmes to the selected farmers on importance of Azolla for livestock & Poultry and its cultivation methods.
- KVK provided technical and financial linkages to the livestock growers to establish Azolla units.
- KVK conducted field trails and demonstrations as part of technical progarmmes in the clusters
- KVK instructional farm and KVK promoted CMRCs act as functional models and resource centre for Azolla cultivation and also providing Azolla seeds & Azolla beds to the farmers.
- KVK developed IEC material on Azolla cultivation technology and its importance for the benefit of farmers.

Outcome and Impact

- > 124 Azolla units have been established in Erode district with the support of KVK
- Farmers felt that feeding 2-3 kg of Azolla along with dairy animal ration can increase milk yield upto 20 %
- > 12 Azolla seed units established in DFI villages and CMRCs for the benefit of farmers.
- > 6 Krishi Mitras trained on Azolla cultivation and providing extension support.
- Line departments identified KVK as a resource centre & Seed bank for Azolla.
- During the year 2017- 2020 KVK and KVK promoted institutions produced and sold 2450 Kgs of Azolla
- By adopting this Azolla cultivation, 20 % feed cost reduced for Backyard poultry production farmers.
- More than 1000 farmers visited the farm for updating their skill and knowledge on Azolla Cultivation.
- KVK published azolla feed production and supply related article in newspapers and popular magazines for wider outreach among the farming community
