World Environmental Day, 2023

Awareness programmes, demonstrations and plantations have been organized during World Environment Day as a part of Mission LiFE.

The programme was organized by KVK ***** at Thinnakadu village Bargur panchayat of Anthiyur block, Erode district on 5.06.2023. Mrs.P.Premalatha, SMS (Soil National Street, Soil National Street, SMS) Science), ICAR KVK, welcomed the farmers during the programme. Mr.P.Pachiappan, SMS (Horticulture), KVK presided and inaugurated the



programme. The programme started with "Environment Day", followed by importance of Climate change and how it affects people's lives and health in various ways. Further importance of safe drinking

water, clean air, supply of nutrient rich food, pollution free environment and importance of hygiene was explained. Additionally, the importance of plantation of Spice and Fruit crops to create micro climate in this area and generate employment opportunity for the farm women and land less people.

Meeting cum Input distribution under SCSP project

KVK, Erode along with CIFT, Cochin organized training program on Value addition in fish and fish waste under SCSP during 04.01.2023 to 06.01.2023 for 20 members. The participants are fishermen group at Kodivery, Gobichettipalayam Taluk.



As a follow up of the training program, Scientist from CIFT organized input distribution of Insulated Ice Box for the trained participants to store the fish and do the marketing and value addition on 13. 06. 23.



Marketing linkages for Fish scales by-products developed by trained participants and scope for production of value added products from dried guts and bladder of fish, fish amino acids etc as an IGP activity for the group members are discussed.

Focused group discussion was held for the development of Schedule caste families for the current year with association of CIFT.

Activity planned for establishing market outlet at Kodivery with value chain activity from fish and fish value added products and by products from fish waste.

Marketing linkages for sales outlet at PKR Arts College for Women

KVK imparted sponsored programme on "Counter sales Executive"

for Rural SC youth from PKR Arts college for women under SCST hub Scheme with ITCOT Erode. After training the trained Students (Rural female youth) were supported with financial linkages from banks with support of KVK. On 11.05.2023, at PKR college they started sales outlet to market the student's product



along with products of SHGs, AESC (Agri Entrepreneurs Service centre) established at KVK, for Entrepreneurship promotion among



college students. KVK will provide technical and marketing support for the college with sales promotion interventions. Further EDP related programmes for the development of EDP cell of the college to motivate youth towards Agriculture related enterprises was discussed. Further It is

planned for extending linkages for AESC with college administration, to sustain the market outlet services.

KVK Scientists Cross Learning

KVK has established Agri Entrepreneur Service Centre (AESC) to support Entrepreneurs and Farmers to market their farm produces and value added products. Neighboring KVKs and NGOs are visiting this



AESC to replicate in their Institutions. In this context, KVK team from Coimbatore with their FPCL farmers (3 staff and 3 farmers) visited KVK on 27.04. 2023. They learnt about process, functions and services of AESC for Entrepreneurship Promotion.

They planned for establishing this model in their KVK. Additionally they also documented the accounts and administrative procedures of the AESC.

After that, they visited Kazhani FPCL promoted by KVK, interacted with FPCL members about their business and services for development of farming community. They also discussed about fu-

ture linkages for product procurement and supply for FPCL growth. Later, they interacted with KVK staff about the functions and services of curcumin lab at KVK and gained knowledge about the testing process to benefit for Turmeric farmer



in their region. The team then visited farm demonstration unit and interacted with farm manager of KVK about the establishment techniques with economics.

Integrated Tribal Development Programme

As a part of Integrated Tribal Development programme, awareness was created among the tribal farmers regarding important the indigenous breeds like Bargur cow and buffalo. KVK also promoted A2 milk marketing through Surabi FPO





and AMRO milk private limited among the tribal farmers. Further, the importance of insuring the animals unexpected events was against explained. 10 tribal farmers were selected and 10 buffalo heifers were distributed to them. These animals were then tagged and insured under New India insurance.

Awareness on IPDM in Coconut



KVK in association with State agriculture department organized awareness camp on pest and disease management in coconut crop on 26.04.2023 at Kullampalayam village, Perunthurai Block. The farmers learnt about nutrient management, pest & diseases of coconut and

management practices. In association with MSTL, Method demonstration of soil sampling was briefed to the farmers. Joint diagnostic field visit organized in association with ARS Bhavanisagar Scientist, ADA and other line department officials and identified Rugose spiralling whitefly and Rhinocerous beetle damage symptoms and recommended suitable corrective measures. 36 farmers and extension officials have participated.

Demonstration on Sugarcane variety (CO11015)

Sugarcane is one of the important crop cultivated over 25000 ha in Erode district. KVK demonstrated latest technologies and varieties in association with ICAR-SBI for the benefit of sugarcane farmers in the district. Follow up of On Farm Trial, KVK demonstrated CO 11015 variety





which is short duration in nature and suitable for jaggery production. The seedlings were produced by using the sugarcane sett treatment Device to prevent the spread of pest and diseases through planting materials. A total of 7500 seedlings provided to

three farmers in the Vellode region and the crop is in vegetative stage.

FPO Farmers Exposure visits

Farmers from 5 FPOs of Raichur district of Karnataka visited KVK on 24.05.2023 for gaining knowledge on Farmer's producer Company. Technical session was handled by Mrs.M.Siva, SMS (Home science) about formation, activities, business plan and KVK experiences in promotion of Farmers



Producer Company. Later, they visited Kazhani FPCL promoted by KVK, discussed with CEO and members. They exposed to Business activities and approaches and methodologies followed for sustainability and effective functioning of FPCLs. They interacted with Agri Entrepreneur Service center established at KVK for promotion of



ANI FARMED A STIPLE AND ENTREPREDEUT AND ENTREPREDEUTS to enhance their income generation skills. After that, the team visited Milk processing unit at KVK for the feasibility to establish in their region. They also learnt about different business promotion activities for the development of their FPCLs with the

major crops of their respective region and networking with FPCLs.

Awareness on Nano Urea in Paddy crop

Paddy is the most important food crop cultivated over 1,0,000 acre in Erode district. Continuous application of granulated form of nitrogenous fertilizers leads to depletion of soil health and less

nutrient use efficiency (30-50 %). In order to address this, KVK conducted demonstration of nano urea application in Paddy during Kharif in 5 farmers field of Koogalur village, Gobi As part of the programme, training and method demonstration of nano urea application through Drone



spraying was conducted on 19.06.2023 in association with IFFCO, Erode. 22 farmers have participated in this programme.

Joint Diagnostic Field Visit

Paddy is the major food crop cultivated over27000 ha in Erode district. Outbreak of pest like stem borer and leaf fodder was noticed in Thadapalli Ayacut region, TN palayam block. Joint Field



visit was made along with Department of Agriculture and Farmer welfare. TN palayam block to study the severity of pest infestation and provided comprehensive management practices for managing the pests. The filed visit was made on

28.06.2023 at Vaniputhur village and also provided advisories on top dressing of fertilizers for improving the growth of the plants. Assistant Director of Agriculure. TN Palayam and other line department officials participated in the programme,

World Honey Bee Day Celebration

ICAR KVK MYRADA Erode District, Kumaraguru College of Agriculture and Honey Entrepreneur jointly organized "Celebration of World Honey Bee Day" at Varapalam village in TN Palayam Block on 20.05.2023. Dr.P.Alagesan, Senior Scientist & Head of KVK presided





and inaugurated the programme. He briefed about the importance of bee keeping and promotion of honey bee enterprises in the district. He also informed that 6 clusters were formed for rearing of honey bees and value addition. He briefed that totally 39 value added

products had been developed by the honey entrepreneurs. Mr.Palaniswamy, Panchayat President described about the bee keeping activities and their promotion. Mr.V.Dhanasekar, Assistant Professor (Agricultural Entomology), Kumaraguru College of Agriculture welcomed the delegates and the participants. He briefed about the rearing techniques of honey bees to the participants. Mr. Kathirvan, Honey Entrepreneur explained about the value addition in honey and also process of developing candles by using honey waxes. KVK supported by providing natural dies and molds to the entrepreneur. 56 farmers have participated.

DAESI Input Dealers Exposure Visits

KVK in coordination with MAN-AGE Hyderabad and SAMETI, Tamil Nadu organized one year Diploma course to Input dealers. 40 participants from Erode and nearby district participated in the programme. Two days exposure visit were



organized on 20.4.2023 and 21.4.2023 to TNAU and ICAR Institutes. Participants were exposed to TNAU Bio control lab and they were briefed about mass production of predators and parasitoids for pest management in agriculture and horticulture crops. Additionally, the participants were exposed to meteorological observatory for weather related parameters and interpretations of data.



Next day participants were exposed to ICAR Soil and Water conservation and Central potato research station they were briefed about soil and water conservation measures and cultivation of potato and nematode management in

Potato crop.
